WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Incredibly dark for Pinot Noir, the color indicates both the depth and the purity of the flavor. This wine exudes a glorious nose of graham cracker, rose petals, dried raspberries, fresh blueberries, and black cherry. The tannins are wonderfully fine-grained and the length is impressive with a beautiful streak of refreshing acidity. The long and juicy finish lingers with fruitful finesse. I'm extremely proud of our third release!
